Cut flowers from Annuals, Award of Merit

Cut flowers from Perennials, Award of Merit

Section C: “Hope Springs Eternal”

Cut flowers from Bulbs, Tubers, Rhizomes or Corms, Award of Merit

Section D: “Strong Arms of Protection”

Arboreal, Arboreal Award

Section E: “Green Side Up”

Cut Decorative Foliage, Award of Merit

Section F: “Beauty Contained”

Containers, Grower’s Choice Award

DIVISION II: DESIGN: “Living Clean”

All designs will be miniature (5”) or small (8”); see HB pg 203-4, 208. Tables draped in black; designs staged and viewed at eye level. Committee provided staging **may not be removed** from Flower Show’s room; nothing may be attached to staging provided by committee.

Section A: Alabama, “Gardening for Gleaning, Greening and Cleaning”

Designer’s Choice Award

Class 1: “Reap what you Sow”

A Miniature Design staged on a black metal candlestick with a 3” circular candle base that is slightly depressed (1/2”) and raised 3” above wooden base.

Class 2: “It’s Easy to be Green”

A Small Design featuring foliage staged in 10”Hx10”Wx4”D section of a gray acrylic shadowbox provided by committee.

Class 3: “A Breath of Fresh Air”

A Small Hanging Design, Type II (HB pg 202). Committee provides 8” gold tone hook with 4” round base and 3” horizontal clearance. (no electricity)

Section B: Florida, “Reach out, be a Mentor”,

Designer’s Choice Award

Class 4: “Me and My Shadow” (mentoring an individual)

A Small Reflective Design to be staged on 6” square clear acrylic riser

Class 5: “Networking” (mentoring a new club or circle)

A Miniature Hanging Design, Type II (HB pg 202); Committee provides 6” gold tone hook with 3” horizontal clearance. (no electricity)

Class 6: “Lending a Hand” (mentoring in our community)

A Small Stretch Design staged in a 10”x10” table top area; background panel required.

Section C: Georgia, “Flourish our Future”

Award of Distinction

Class 7: “Thriving”

A Small Creative Mass Design (HB pg 200) staged on a 6”square black cube riser.

Class 8: “Primed for the Future”

A Miniature Creative Design staged in a 7”Tx7”Wx4”D gray acrylic shadowbox

Class 9: “Tomorrow is our Focus”

A Collage Design (HB pg 197-8) to be 8” square; staged on easel provided by committee

Section D: Louisiana, Protect and Conserve Our Natural Resources”

Tricolor Award

Class 10: “Recycle, Reduce, Reuse, Rethink”

A Small Assemblage Design (HB pg197); staged in a 10”x10” area on table top;
Designer provides all staging.

Class 11: “Under the Live Oak Trees”

A Small Hanging Design, Type II (HB pg 202) to be suspended from committee provided oak branch. Designer to bring hook (monofilament line provided)

Class 12: “Oh! H2O”

A Miniature Design featuring water; staged on a 6”sq. cork tile provided by committee

Section E: Mississippi, “Know it, Grow it, Show it”

Tri-color Award

Class 13: “Botanica”,

A Small Mono-Botanic Design (HB pg 204) staged on clear acrylic risers with 4 1/2” sq tops (varied heights). Plant materials, grown by the exhibitor, to be listed on 3”x5” card.

Class 14: “A Class of its Own”

A Miniature Design staged on a 5”sq portion of open black shelf provided by committee

Class 15: “Hortulana”

A Small Design featuring the color green; using a frame, provided by designer, in an area 10”x10” on table top.

Section F: Tennessee, “Train First for Green & Clean: Get on the Green Track”

Award of Distinction

Class 16: “All Aboard!”

A Miniature design to be creatively staged in a niche, provided by designer, in an 8”square area.

Class 17: “Making Tracks and Riding the Rails”

A Small Parallel Design (HB pg 206) staged in a 10”x10” area using a background panel provided by designer

Class 18: “The TFGC Express”

A Small Angular Design (HB pg 196-7) staged on a round cork mat with an 8” diameter. Cork mat provided by committee.
